NOTE: There are duplicates in this collection, and the photos are not in a specific order. Most photos are originals, some are negatives from which originals were printed.

This collection of about 1100 photos will always be a work in progress. Captions for and dates of photos were very often missing. “Best guess” captions and dates were provided between 2015 and 2018 by Dick Bernard, oldest grandchild of the Busch’s, born 1940, whose work on the family history began in 1980, with very good knowledge of the farm, it’s individual members and their children, the family history and direct knowledge of the relative age of all the children and grandchildren. While impossible to determine with absolute certainty, the estimates in most cases are probably quite accurate; they are more than “educated guesses”; at minimum they provide a base for further research.

If a particular photo is preceded by a letter, this is the meaning:

B – early Berlin ND ca 1910

C – **Church**, usually related to St. Johns Catholic Church, Berlin ND

F – General farming scenes

H – Hunting and fishing

M – **Military**, specifically World War II era

P – likely at Grand Rapids (ND) Veterans Memorial Park (established after WWI)

S – **School**, most often Henrietta #1, Henrietta Township, LaMoure Co., where all nine Busch children went to the eight grades of elementary school from 1915-41.

W – Photo in **Wisconsin**, most likely Hazel Green Township, Grant County, occasionally, also, Dubuque Iowa, home areas of Busch and Berning families from well before 1900

2000 – Deconstruction of the original farmhouse

1993 – Family Reunion at Veterans Memorial Park Grand Rapids MN; includes photos of 1994 reunion of the same family at Sinsinawa WI
