### Selected data for UN members

#### By column

1. **Current name.**
2. **Date of admission to United Nations** (where two dates are given, the first indicates admission as part of another nation from which the nation named was later separated; the second indicates when the nation was admitted in its own right).
3. **Population** (in 000s, 2010).
4. **Population as percentage of total.**
5. **UN assessment** (percentage of regular budget).
6. **GNI** (gross national income, US\$ billion, 2009).
7. **GNI as percentage of total.**
8. **Weighted vote** in proposed General Assembly (based on 2009–2010 data); GNI data used for assessment term in weighted voting formula.
9. **Economic bloc:** OECD, G-77 or neither (N).
10. **Freedom House rating** (based on average scores for political liberties and civil liberties, 2010; F, Free; PF, Partly free; and NF, Not free).
11. **Proposed Security Council regions:** **AF**, Africa South of the Sahara; **AL**, Arab League; **CH**, China; **EA**, East Asia; **EU**, Europe; **IN**, India; **LA**, Latin America and Caribbean; **RU**, Russia and certain neighbouring republics; **SE**, Southeast Asia; **US**, United States; **WA**, West Asia, **WL**, Westminster League.
